
## The Social Difficulties Inventory (SDI-21) scoring guide

The Social Difficulties Inventory (SDI-21) is a 21 item questionnaire. Responses to all items are on a 4 point scale ranging from "0" no difficulty to "3" very much difficulty.

The SDI may be reported in three ways:

- 1. Individual item scores
- 2. Three subscale scores: Everyday living, Money matters, Self and others
- 3. Social Distress (SD-16) score

The output may be displayed as a "one off" or as a serial output. A cut point indicating levels of social distress that may warrant further investigation has been calculated (**cut point value** ≥ 10) and also the clinically meaningful difference in changes in score over time for the SD (**increase of 3**) and subscale (**increase of 2**) scores derived.
